

SWR17/18 Leg 10

1. Kipper1258's 'request for redress' from SRC (13th June 23:35) was submitted within the time limit for a 'protest'.
2. The Sailonline Racing Rules ('**SRR**') do NOT include the Racing Rules of Sailing ('**RRS**') that apply in real life. (For example port/starboard, windward/leeward, water at a mark or continuing obstruction, overlap, overtaking rules etc. etc. do not apply in SOL racing.)
3. SRC submits that it cannot consider any portions of RRS to apply to racing in SOL and so its decision is as follows:
 - a. **RRS Rules do not apply to Sailonline Racing.**
 - b. **Whilst any interaction of coding between beaching and a possible DC was unfortunate it arose simply because Kipper1258 was too close to the shore.**
 - c. **SRC has not been shown any rules or grounds upon which Kipper1258 should be entitled to individual redress from the Race Committee.**
 - d. **The 'request for redress' is denied and the result of the SWR17/18 Leg 10 race stands as recorded by Operations.**
