Sailonline Nav Sim AB, the Sailonline Corporation, will host the 2016 Corporate OPEN Gold Championship, open to the entire Sailonline Racing Community. The following rules will apply:

# 1. Race calendar and Championship CODE

The 2016 Corporate OPEN Gold Championship ( Code : COGC ) will be run over **four** individual Races (one each quarter ).

The Race Committee will publish the relevant Calendar, advertising well in advance which race will be eligible for the Championship in every single quarter.





# 2. Race and Series FORMAT

Each race of this Championship will carry the following FORMAT :

- Only the DATE and START TIME of each race will be published in advance within the Quarterly calendars.
- The course venue and the boat will be announced and made visible only during the last few days prior to start.
- The four start times during 2016 will be : 1200Z 1800Z 0000Z and 0600Z for fairness to all areas.
- Each race will last approximately between two and four hours ( Super Sprint ) and is expected to be HOT ( hands on tiller ) all the time.
- Routers are expected to be useless.
- As the Corporate Championship is OPEN , ALL the boats will run for the SERIES final prizes , regardless of SYC membership.

# 3. Race Ranking system

In each Corporate Open Gold Championship race ALL boats will be scored as per ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2013/2016 Appendix A. ( Low point system ).

# 4. Number of races valid for the series (discards)

All **4** results out of **4** for each boat will form the Series score for that boat. ( No discards allowed) . In case of ties comma A8 of ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing Appendix A will be used to break the tie.





# 5. Racing rules

*Obviously some of ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing do not apply in SOL due to technical reasons. All the remaining rules will apply.* 

SOL's general rules as published by SRC apply to each Championship race, as to any race in SOL.

# 6. Race Committee

The Race Committee, in association with SOAR/OPS may decide to apply a time limit for each race. This will aim to leave ample time for every boat to finish on the course after the leading boats have finished the race.

The Race Committee will be fully responsible for enforcing Rule 69.1 of the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing , and their judgment will be without appeal.

### 7. Prizes

All entrant boats (SYC members and non SYC members) will be eligible for prizes associated with individual races, as well as with prizes related to final Series rankings.

Final series Ranking Award Certificates will be issued to top 40 finishers as ranked in the final Series rankings.

# 8. Prizes Delivery

#### GENERAL NOTE :

The prize delivery provisions can apply only to those boats and skippers who have provided their data to SRC. Should any skipper want to avoid the procedure listed hereunder they can at any time write an email to

#### INDIVIDUAL RACES :

Skippers finishing a Championship race within TOP 20 positions need to contact WITHIN 72 HOURS from his/her time of finish SRC at following address

containing the following data :

- --- Boat name and flag
- --- Skipper's name and surname





--- The race winner will need to add the full postal address.

Once the 72 hours have elapsed, should SRC not have the required information from the eligible skippers, the prize will be considered as undeliverable.

Every possible effort will be made to deliver prizes in case information gets to SRC after the deadline, but there will be no guarantee.

In 2016 there will be NO publication of uncollected prizes lists.

#### SERIES CHAMPIONSHIP:

Skippers finishing the Championship within TOP 40 positions need to contact SRC WITHIN 7 days from Championship Final Rankings Publication at following address

containing the following data:

- --- Boat name and flag
- --- Skipper's name and surname
- --- The Championship winner will need to add the full postal address.

Once the 7 days have elapsed, should SRC not have the required information from the eligible skippers, the prize will be considered as undeliverable.

Every possible effort will be made to deliver prizes in case information gets to SRC after the deadline, but there will be no guarantee.

The actual deadline to provide information for prize collection will be advertised together with the Final Rankings Publication.

In 2016 there will be NO publication of uncollected prizes lists.
