




SOL RACE RECORD

Founded by naval architect Michel Dufour in 1957, Dufour Yachts, nowadays part of the Fountaine-Pajot Group, builder of luxury catamarans and originally 470 dinghies, have launched a veritable multitude of designs which, like those of Citroen Car, that other icon of "je-ne-sais-quoi", have sometimes been strange, but always innovative.

Up into the 1980s, Michel designed all his company's boats himself, and 1974's Dufour 34 with a very proper pointy bow is a good example of his flair for style. Designed with the cruising market in mind, she is a beamy beauty with fin-and-skeg below the waterline, giving her quite a good performance for a 25ft waterline yacht. There are not many left afloat today, but on SOL she sails on forever.
