





Seascape 18 single-handed

After competing at the front end of the Mini6.50 fleet for half a decade in their Sam Manuard designed prototypes, Slovenian friends Andraž Mihelik and Kristian Hajnšek decided there had to be an opportunity to translate the essential hull and rig concepts of the Mini into a small, fast, simple production boat.

By 2009, their new company, Seascape in Ljubljana – 100 km inland from Trieste at the top of the Adriatic, but less than 1km distant from one of the main central European railway marshalling yards! – had translated their ambition into the Seascape 18. Again designed by Sam Manuard, but obviously with considerable input from the two young entrepreneurs, you can read more about her design features here. On SOL we sail her fully-crewed and single-handed. This is the polar for the single-hander, appropriately enough as illustrated adjacent.
