





SOL RACE RECORD

The Twister Association tells us that the first Twister was designed in 1963 by Kim Holman in Essex, England, to be a truly competitive all-wood racing yacht. About 30 wooden Twisters were built and as the design was becoming increasingly popular, at the end of the 1960s a GRP racer/cruiser was developed.

A true modern classic long-keeler, the design stayed in production up into the mid 1980s, and over 200 were built.

On SOL, she was added to the boatshed in 2010 for that year's Twisted Race from Plymouth to Fowey to compete against SOLer GC in her very own Twister 28, IRL. Perhaps that's her adjacent.
